A Eurostat report published earlier this month also revealed that Spain was the third biggest job creator in the Eurozone between April and June this year. As such, the number of people in work during the second quarter of 2014 compared with the first quarter grew by 0.7%, almost half a per cent more than the Eurozone average.

Despite still falling product prices and high unemployment in Spain, economists are hopeful that reforms enacted over the past two years will continue to enhance growth over the next few months.
